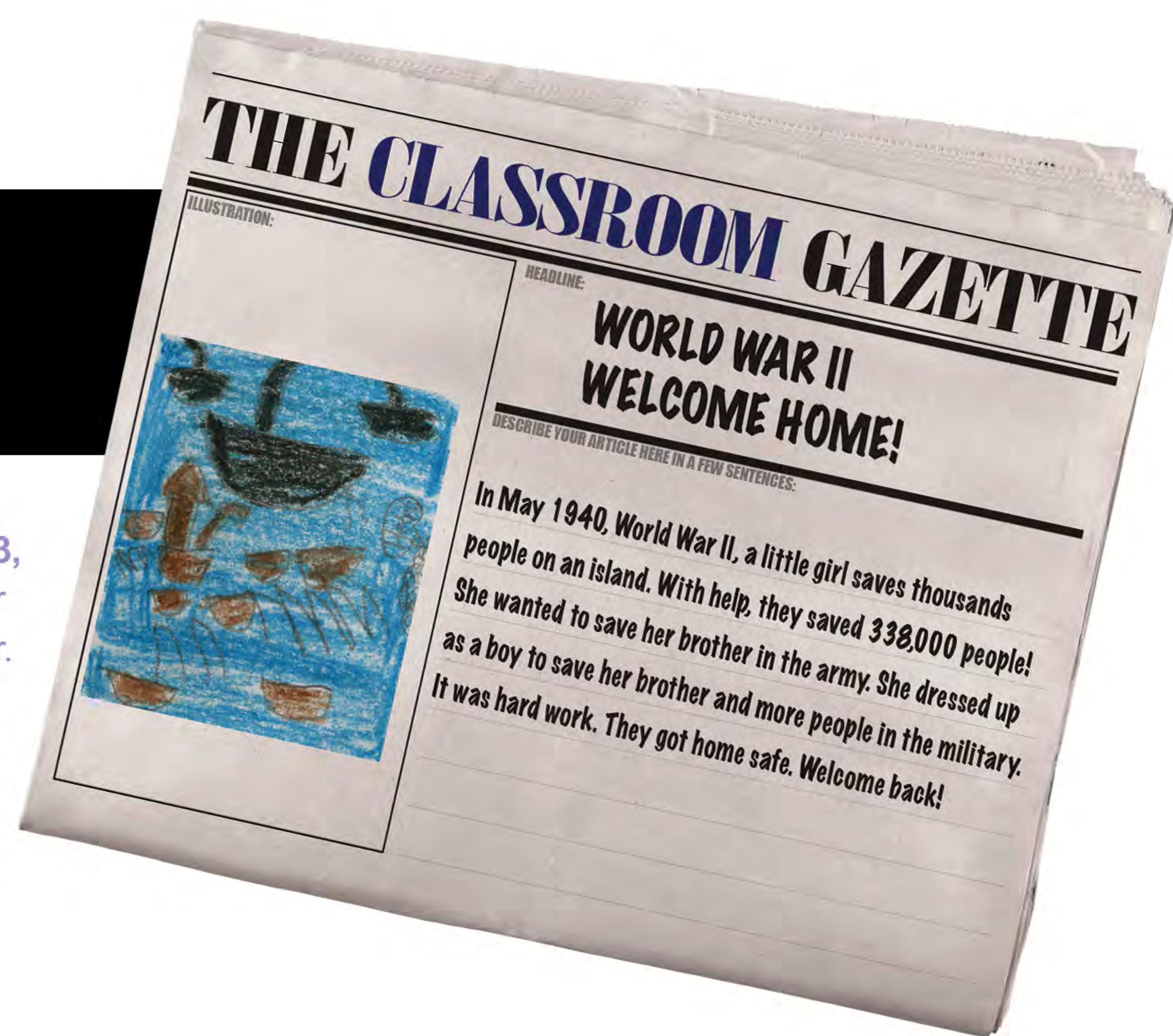
DEADLINE: All entries must be received by **November 3, 2017**. All entries **MUST** include student name; teacher name; and school name, address, and phone number.

Entries must be no more than 200 words.


